Position Title: Urban Forestry Specialist

Job Type: Temporary, full-time/non-exempt (40 hours a week) through September, possible transition to permanent status.

Compensation: \$18.50 an hour. Benefits include three weeks of PTO per year plus paid holidays.

Location: Davis, CA

Overview: Tree Davis is seeking someone to join our team to support our summertime tree stewardship activities. We're looking for someone who enjoys working outside and caring for young trees.

About Tree Davis: Our mission is to improve the health and resilience of our communities by enhancing and expanding Climate-Ready Trees and Landscapes through direct action, community engagement, and advocacy.

Job Description: Under general supervision, provide stewardship to young trees that are planted in public spaces throughout the City of Davis. Along with the day to day work, seek ways to create efficiencies in stewardship processes.

Duties

- Perform stewardship based on the specific needs of the trees and based on work orders: water, remove weeds, add mulch, remove stakes/replace stakes
- Determine general health of trees and recommend future stewardship
- Enter tree stewardship updates into database
- Ensure that the organization's work truck and other equipment is maintained and is in good working order
- Support Tree Davis' volunteer events - ensure that volunteers are participating effectively and safely
- Other duties as assigned

Mandatory Qualifications

- Valid California driver's license and comfortable driving a full sized truck
- Professional or academic interest in arboriculture, natural resource management, biology, or a related field
- Experience working independently
- Able to work weekdays and some weekends
- Able to do sustained physical labor, able to lift up to 50 pounds
- Able to work outdoors in inclement weather, especially hot temperatures
- Effective written and verbal communication skills
- Can assist in logistics and coordination of the tree stewardship program
- Knows how to take initiative and knows how to problem solve

Preferred Qualifications

- Experience with Salesforce or other databases
- Experience with tree identification and care
- Experience with volunteer events
