



Memorial Grove Update:

Tree Davis Board Members and staff catalyzed a revitalization effort of the 20-year old Tree Davis Memorial Grove. Tree Davis has inventoried and tagged commemorative trees and developed a design that envisions five mini-groves, each planted with climate-ready trees and understory plants that attract pollinators, birds and wildlife. The renovation will demonstrate shrub and turf conversions with use of lower maintenance species to create rich habitats and serene settings.



This location was also the setting of our virtual dedication event to honor Tree Davis' Founding Member, urban forest champion and former California State Senator, Lois Wolk.
