City of Davis

In 2024, Tree Davis strengthened it's 30+ year partnership with the City of Davis, planting 154 trees in public spaces. Tree Davis continued its enhancements of the Memorial Grove, hosting volunteer events to introduce climate-ready, understory landscaping.

A highlight of the year was a vibrant Arbor Day celebration at N Street Park, and the surrounding Davis Manor neighborhood where volunteers planted and cared for trees. The event included a tour of climate-ready plants and tree pruning demonstrations.

In collaboration with the City of Davis Urban Forestry Division, Tree Davis also contributed to the continued development of an updated climate-ready master tree list. This project will support the city's long-term urban forest planning efforts.



2024 ACCOMPLISHMENTS



Climate-Ready Education

In 2022, Tree Davis launched the Climate-Ready Urban Forestry Education Program for high school students in Yolo County, with funding from CAL FIRE. The program aims to provide students with hands-on technical experiences in environmental stewardship and introduce them to career pathways in the field of urban forestry.

During the Spring and Fall semesters of 2024, this program served a total of 50 students across 5 individual campuses in Davis, Winters, and West Sacramento. Students, along with community members, planted 95 trees in schoolyards and public spaces.

Cool Schools Yolo

In 2024, Tree Davis, in partnership with the Woodland Tree Foundation and Texas Trees Foundation, launched a multi-year greening initiative across nine school campuses within the Washington and Woodland Unified School Districts. This ambitious effort began with a series of community engagement events to understand the unique needs and priorities of each campus. These sessions also informed the planning of site-specific nature education components, ensuring the revitalized outdoor spaces would support both learning and community connection.

Construction and site improvements across all campuses are anticipated to be completed in 2026. Once finished, these enhanced green spaces will provide lasting benefits for generations of students—promoting physical and mental well-being, climate resilience, and place-based education rooted in sustainability.
